

NOTICE – CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS

TAX INCREMENT FINANCING REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA REGISTRATION FOR INTERESTED PARTIES REGISTRY

Pursuant to Section § 5/11-74.4-4.2 of the Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act, 65 ILCS § 5/11-74.4-1 et seq. (the “Act”), the City of Springfield is required to establish an Interested Parties registry (“Registry” or “Registries”) for each Tax Increment Financing (“TIF”) redevelopment project area created pursuant to the Act (a “Redevelopment Project Area”) whether existing as of the date of this notice or hereafter established. On November 21st, 2000 the City adopted an ordinance (643-11-00) authorizing the establishment of Registries and establishing registration rules for such Registries. The purpose of this notice is to inform Interested Parties of the Registries and registration rules for the Registries and to invite Interested Parties (as defined below) to register in the Registry for any Redevelopment Project Area.

Any organization active within the City and/or any resident of the City (an “Interested Party”) is entitled to register in the Registry for any Redevelopment Project Area. Organizations include, but are not limited to, businesses, business organizations, civic groups, not-for-profit corporations and community organizations.

An organization seeking to register as an Interested Party with respect to a Redevelopment Project Area must complete and submit a Registration Application Form, which can be obtained by clicking on the link below. An individual must submit a copy of a current driver’s license, lease, voter registration card, utility bill, financial statement, or such other evidence as may be acceptable to the Office of Planning & Economic Development to establish the individual’s current residency in the City.

An Interested Party Registry is being established for the following TIF Redevelopment Project Areas:

- Central Area Tax Increment Redevelopment Project Area
- Enos Park Tax Increment Redevelopment Project Area
- S. H. A. Tax Increment Redevelopment Project Area
- Far East Tax Increment Redevelopment Project Area
- Fiat Allis Complex Tax Increment Redevelopment Project Area (expires Nov 7, 2012)
- Northeast TIF Redevelopment Project Area
- Jefferson Crossing Project Area
- Proposed MacArthur Boulevard Corridor Redevelopment Project Area

All individuals and organizations whose Registration Application Form and supporting documentation comply with the registration rules and who submit such documentation to the Office of Planning and Economic Development will be registered in the applicable Registry within ten (10) business days of the Office of Planning and Economic Development’s receipt of all such documents. If the Office of Planning and Economic Development determines that a applicant’s Registration Application Form and/or supporting documentation is incomplete or does not comply with the registration rules adopted by the City, the Office of Planning and Economic Development will give written notice to the applicant specifying the defects. The applicant will be entitled to correct any defects and resubmit a new Registration Application Form and supporting documentation.

Upon registration, Interested Parties shall be entitled to receive all notices required under the Act, including how to obtain information concerning the applicable Redevelopment Project Area. The City reserves the right to charge recipients for the cost of copies and postage/delivery charges for requested documents.

An Interested Party’s registration will remain effective for a period of three (3) years. A new form must be completed and submitted every three (3) to remain on the Registry. Each registry will be available for public inspection at Office of Planning and Economic Development during the City’s normal business

hours. The Registry will include the name, address, and telephone number of each Interested Party; and for organizations, the name and phone number of a designated contact person.
