## **Rental and Utility Assistance Resources**

The first thing one can do is negotiate a payment plan with your landlord or utility provider. Even partial payments can help. This can keep you from going further into debt and buy you more time to find a solution to your problem.

Funding may or may not be available at any given time, so call ahead. Keep in mind most places that give out assistance for rent and or utilities will have a process so plan on it taking some time. Even when funds are available it may take several days or even weeks for funding to come through. Remember to ask what documents or identification you need to bring as requirements may vary from place to place. This will speed up the process.
