



Procedure and Contacts for the Entire Demolition of a Structure

Note: As of January 1, 2001, all demolition permits shall require **proof of notification to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA)**, regardless of the type of structure. A file stamped copy from the IEPA will be kept with the permit file. Before the department will accept a demolition permit application, **written verification of the disconnection of utility services** is required.

6 REQUEST INSPECTION

Required inspections of cleaned basement cavity and sewer disconnect or final grade scheduled prior to 8:15a will be inspected that afternoon (12:00p-4:00p). Any request prior to 3:15p will be made the following morning (8:00a-11:59a). All demolition debris shall have been removed from the property at the time of the inspection, and any basement floor shall be broken into sections no larger than 4'x4'. A sewer cap location inspection shall be scheduled by calling 217.789.2255.
