**In the Matter of Class D and Class E Liquor Licenses During the State of Illinois’
Emergency Declaration Related to the COVID-19 Outbreak**

ORDER OF THE LIQUOR COMMISSIONER

NOW COMES, the Local Liquor Commissioner, Mayor James O. Langfelder, pursuant to the powers granted by Chapter 90 of the City of Springfield Code of Ordinances, as amended 1988, with this Order addressing Class D and Class E Liquor Licenses during the State of Illinois’ Emergency Declaration related to the COVID-19 Outbreak.

1. Section 90.15(g) of the City of Springfield Code of Ordinances states as follows:

Class D. A class D license shall entitle the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor, by the drink or pitcher, as part of a restaurant business, for consumption on the premises only. The annual fee for such license shall be \$800.

2. Section 90.15(h) of the City of Springfield Code of Ordinances states as follows:

Class E. A class E license shall entitle the licensee to sell beer and wine only, by the drink or pitcher, as part of a restaurant business, for consumption on the premises only. The annual fee for such license shall be \$500.

3. The State of Illinois has issued an emergency declaration due to the outbreak of COVID-19.


THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

4. In response and in accordance with the State of Illinois’ emergency declaration and subsequent executive orders, and notwithstanding applicable provisions of Chapter 90 of the City of Springfield Code of Ordinances, I hereby authorize **Class D** local liquor license holders to sell, with the sale of takeout food orders, unopened alcoholic liquor in its original packaging for off premises consumption. This authorization shall take immediate effect and expire upon the lifting of the State of Illinois’ emergency declaration related to the COVID-19 outbreak.
5. In response and in accordance with the State of Illinois’ emergency declaration and subsequent executive orders, and notwithstanding applicable provisions of Chapter 90 of the City of Springfield Code of Ordinances, I hereby authorize **Class E** local liquor license holders to sell, with the sale of takeout food orders, unopened beer and wine in its original

packaging for off premises consumption. This authorization shall take immediate effect and expire upon the lifting of the State of Illinois' emergency declaration related to the COVID-19 outbreak.

6. The service of any alcoholic liquor pursuant to the above conditions is subject to all rules and regulations set forth by the State of Illinois.
